Your child is working on Units of Sound, an online literacy intervention programme that covers Reading, Spelling, Memory and Dictation. Your child has been identified as someone who will benefit from using the programme in order to boost reading and writing skills, so we wanted to tell you a bit about it and why it is so effective.

What is Units of Sound?

Units of Sound is a highly structured literacy intervention programme that improves reading, writing and spelling through multi-sensory activities. Students are placed at a level that's exactly right for them, so they should always feel they are working comfortably.

When is this happening?

The Units of Sound sessions are scheduled timeslots during the week at school (or as part of the set lesson if being tutored privately). A typical session will last 25/30 mins and include some 1:1 progress checking and writing work with the tutor, as well as computer work. The design of Units of Sound allows the student to work largely independently on the computer and this makes it effective to use at home too. Parents will receive a Units of Sound report at the end of each term.
